Year 2 Multi-skills Sports Festival – Kingsmead School – Wednesday 5th December 2018

On Wednesday 5th December 2018 Year 2 pupils have the opportunity of participating in a Multi-skills sports morning at Kingsmead School. They will join in with pupils from the other feeder schools. They will need to come to school in their school PE kit and trainers.

The children will travel by coach to Kingsmead leaving **at 9.15 am** and will return to school in time for lunch.

It is intended that this type of activity will be undertaken on the basis of voluntary contributions towards the cost and are asking for a contribution of **£4.50 per child** to cover the cost of the coach to and from the venue.
