### Lost property

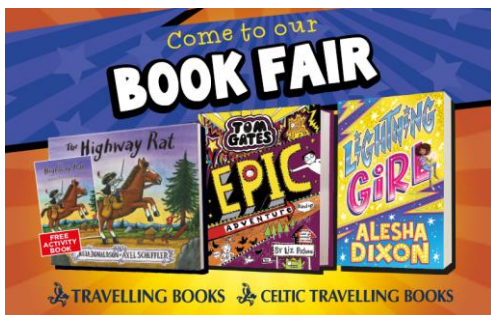
We have so much unnamed lost property – please have a look and retrieve any items that may belong to you. All lost property not collected by the end of next week will be recycled on to the sale rail.
