### Clarks Shoe Museum Trip – Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> September

On Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> September, Years 1 and 2 will be going on a school trip to Street to visit the Clarks Shoe Museum. The visit will be used to learn about different types of shoes and how they have changed over time. We will then take part in a workshop where we will make items linked to “The Elves and the Shoemaker” story.

We will leave school at 9.15am and return to school at approximately 2.30pm. Children will be provided with a fruit snack and a school packed lunch. **The children will need to wear school uniform and bring a drink and coat.**

It is intended that this type of activity will be undertaken on the basis of voluntary contributions towards the cost and we are asking for a contribution of **£8.10 per child** to cover the cost of the coach and workshop.

I would be grateful if your contribution could be made via ParentPay **by Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2018** to enable us to make the decision on the viability of the trip taking place. Please note that in line with the Bath and Wells Multi Academy Trust Charging and Remissions Policy, if insufficient voluntary contributions are received and the trip is not financially viable, we regret that the trip may be cancelled and any monies received will be returned. Children whose parents are in receipt of certain ‘support’ payment may be eligible for further remissions. Please contact the office for more information or speak to the Headteacher in confidence.
