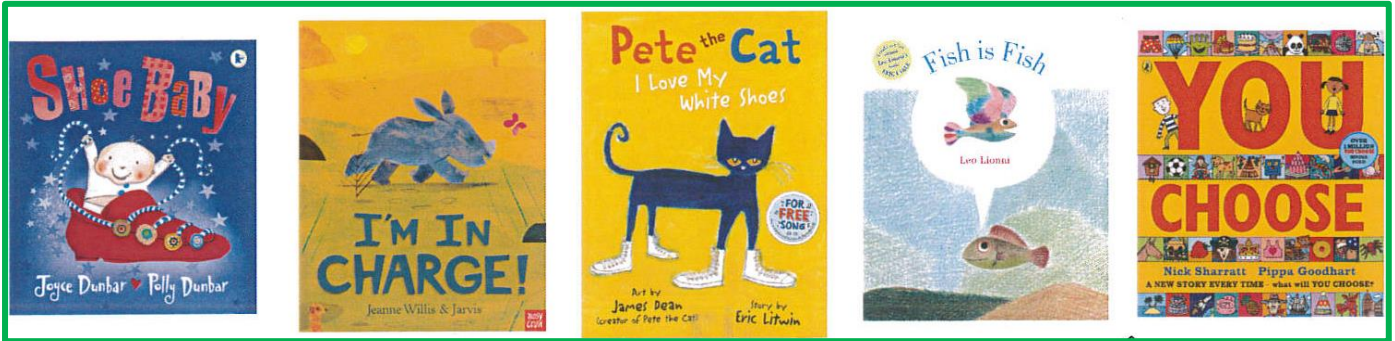
There will be no after-school clubs next Wednesday due to safeguarding training for all staff and volunteers.

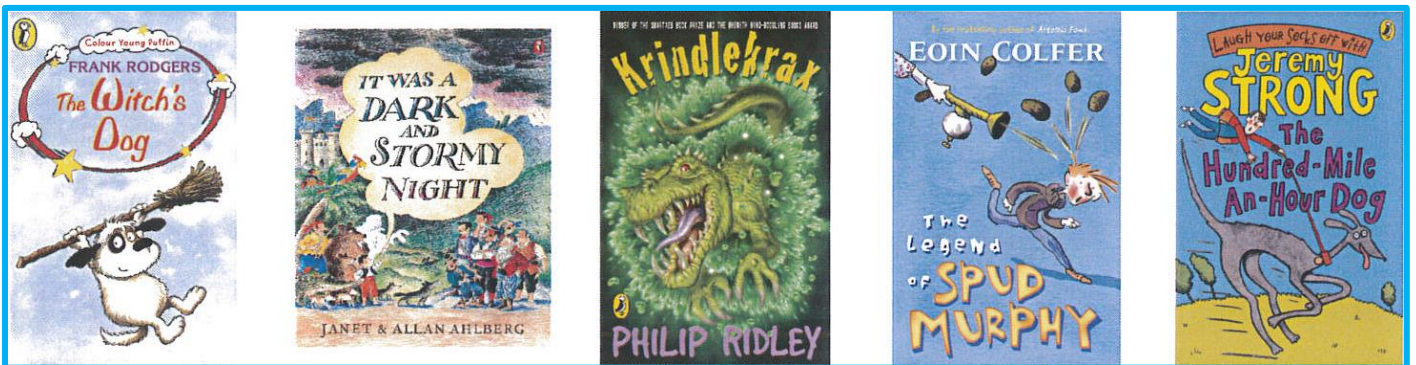

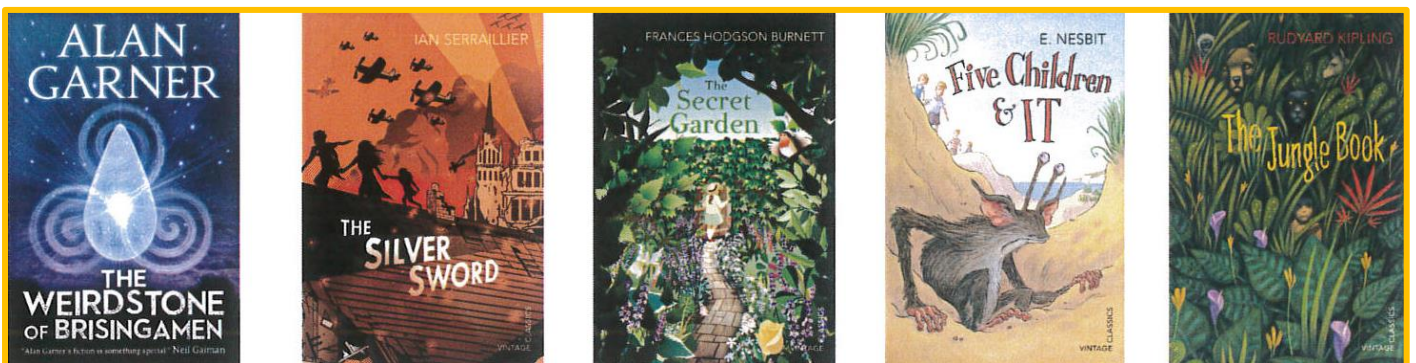
