## English

We will use Jack and the Beanstalk as a stimulus for writing our own stories. We will explore different sentence structures and continue to practise using punctuation correctly. We will write non-chronological reports on a fictional character that we have created. We will use Bramble, Cat and Heron to explore losing tales and create our own stories on this theme. We will learn to identify pattern and rhyme in poetry.

## Maths

As mathematicians we will continue our work on addition and subtraction facts and calculations. We will develop measurement skills and collect data through our topic work activities. In year 2 we will begin to learn multiplication and division. We will learn how to find fractions of amounts and shapes.

## Science

We will explore how to keep our bodies healthy through eating healthy foods, exercise and keeping clean. We will explore our senses and carry out some investigations using our senses.

## Outdoor Learning

We will be exploring our outdoor areas in school to create sculptures for Jack and the Beanstalk, as well as looking at using nature to create pictures of famous people who have impacted our lives.

### WHY?

As explorers we want to develop an enquiring mind and ask questions about the world around us and about ourselves.

## Computing

In Computing we will be covering two units; Multimedia and Technology in Our Lives. We will focus on presenting information and trusting the internet and our searches.

## Religious Education

**Year 1** - Our RE this term will be focusing on Incarnation. We will be looking back at Christmas and thinking about why it is important to Christians and how the nativity guides Christians in their beliefs and actions.

**Year 2** - In RE we will be focussing on special stories in both Judaism and Christianity, as well as studying the Easter Story in greater depth. The Special Stories and Books theme will focus on why they are special, what makes them special and what do people use the books and stories for.

## History

We will learn about the lives of significant people that have made an impact in some way such as Florence Nightingale, Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake.

## Art and Design & DT

We will use clay and other media to create art work linked to faces. We will create our own giants using textiles. During space week we will create some space themed art. We will make observational drawings of fruits and vegetables and explore printing. We will design and make healthy pizzas.

## Music

As musicians we will learn songs linked to the themes of the body, food and space. We will explore instruments to accompany songs.

## Physical Education

We will be exploring techniques and developing skills through target practice and games with our sports coach. We will learn and play team games and improve our throwing and catching skills.

### CHRISTIAN VALUES

This term we will consider how we can show endurance in our work and how significant people have shown endurance in difficult times. We will reflect on how we feel when we succeed through effort and endurance.
