### Shoes

The school wants all children to be safe while they're at school and to grow into healthy adults. The Governors believe that it is dangerous and unsuitable for children to wear shoes that have platform soles, high heels, sling-backs or strappy open toed sandals. We will also not permit trainers to be worn because they are not in keeping with the smart appearance of a school.

### Jewellery, Make-up and Hair Styles

We do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. The exceptions are ear ring studs in pierced ears, small objects of religious significance and a watch. Children will be required to remove these items during P.E. The school cannot be responsible for any loss or damage to these items.

The school does not permit any body art or allow children to wear any make-up, including nail varnish.

The school does not permit children to have unsuitable haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children. This includes tramlines, spiking and gelling hair or having false extensions. The definition of an unsuitable hairstyle is at the discretion of the Headteacher and Governors.
