Dear Parents and Carers,

Owl and Badger Class trip to the Fleet Air Arm Museum, Wednesday 7th December 2022

On **Wednesday 7th December** Owl and Badger classes will be going on a trip to the Fleet Air Arm Museum. We will be taking part in educational workshops, including building our own balsawood airplanes and exploring the museum. Our focus will be on our topic of 'Whose footsteps do we follow in.' This will include impactful science objectives and a dive into our local area history.

To make the most of our time at the museum we will need all children to be in early **in school uniform** and ready to **leave promptly at 9.00am. They will need packed lunches and waterproof jackets.** We will return to school at approximately **3.15pm** but will keep the school office updated on our progress home.

It is intended that this type of activity will be undertaken on the basis of voluntary contributions towards the cost and we are asking for a contribution of **£13.20 per child** to cover the cost of the coach, workshops and entry to the museum.

Please note that in line with the Bath and Wells Multi Academy Trust Charging and Remissions Policy, if insufficient voluntary contributions are received and the trip is not financially viable, we regret that the trip may be cancelled and any monies received will be returned.
