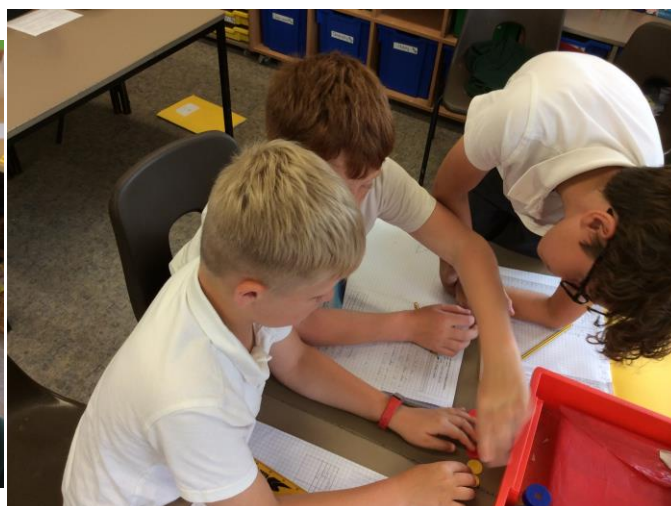
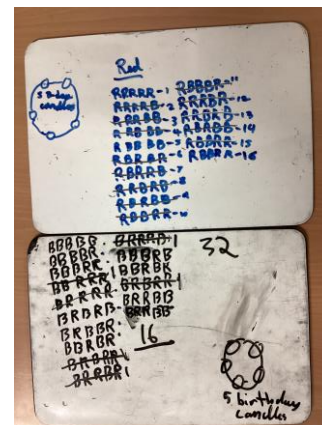
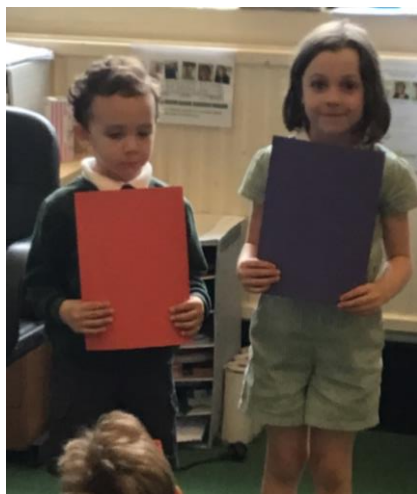
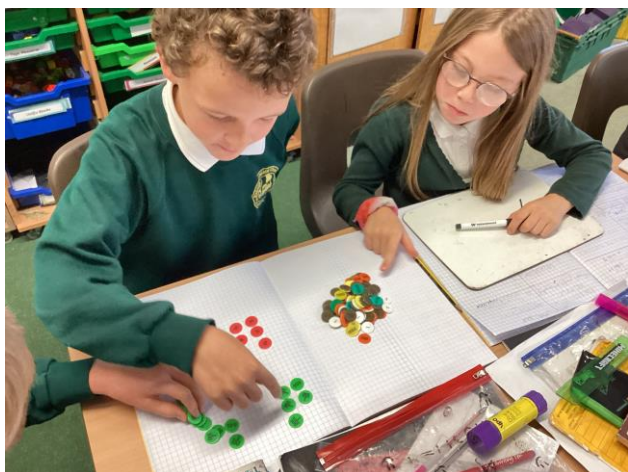


Maths BWMAT Birthday Activity

This week, as part of the Bath and Wells Multi Academy Trust's 10th birthday celebrations, we have completed a maths investigation as a school. We investigated how many possible ways up to 10 candles of 2 different colours could be arranged on a birthday cake.

We explored and represented this in different ways: using ourselves, counters, cubes, coloured paper, colouring squares, representations of candles and tables in order to identify patterns. We had to use the problem solving skill of working systematically in order to list all possibilities. We had to be certain we hadn't missed anything out.

In each class there was a buzz of activity and many observations made and questions asked. Fantastic!

 Two of our smallest schools became part of our Trust in 2020, the year of the pandemic.



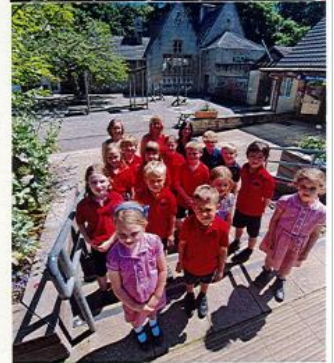
2021
