Ladybird Class





In Ladybird we made our own Easter rabbits and chicks. We created them using a variety of materials and then cut our own photos out to put as the animal faces. We had lots of un creating these and show casing our artwork to the whole school.

Owl Class

We created colourful crosses for the Easter service and read Easter acrostic poems focussing on what Easter means to me. The children discussed what they do for Easter (mainly eat chocolate) and who they see. Owl class enjoyed sharing their work with the school and watching the other classes share too.



In the last week of term, we also painted our Greek pots. We used acrylic paint to make them vibrant and used the same colour tones the Greeks would have used.



Badger Class

At the very end of the Spring Term, Badger Class concluded their Ceramics unit by creating clay pots in the style of Alison Britton by mimicking the same technique she uses - coiling! Once our clay pots/jugs were complete, we used acrylic paint to decorate them, drawing inspiration from the colours of Ancient Greek pottery where possible.







Dragonfly Class



Dragonfly Class shared their Easter story wheels during the school Easter Service and shared some of their written reflections on the story. During their RE lessons, they had been considering different parts of the Easter story and wrote short diary accounts from the viewpoint of those involved using their empathy and reflection skills as theologians to imagine what it must have felt like. They also reflected on what the Easter story might mean to Christians today.

Children in After School Club enjoyed making Easter cakes and creating an Easter garden.











Please note that the Glamorgan sausage on Tuesday of week 1 of the new menu is a vegetarian leek and cheese sausage.


